What is Honours?

Honours is a one-year program of study that can provide entry to further postgraduate training or alternatively, can provide access to a more exciting range of employment opportunities. Honours provides invaluable in-depth practical training, particularly in the areas of research methods and problem solving, and communication skills. You will work side by side with world class research supervisors on highly relevant research projects.

How do I find a project?

The first step is to choose a general discipline area and a relevant supervisor in a school, centre or external organisation. You can find staff on school and centre web sites and approach them directly or you can attend the SMI Honours Information Session.

How do I apply?

Once you have chosen a supervisor and agreed on a project, you should contact the school administration office for further information.
